BASIC SHOP STEWARD

This course is designed for interested members who are looking at becoming Shop Stewards or are new Shop Stewards. Participants will become more familiar with the CUPW Constitution and your Collective Agreement. This course will focus on the role of the Shop Steward to enforce the Collective Agreement, deal with the Constitution and familiarize members with the struggles of CUPW.

HUMAN RIGHTS

This course provides an overview of the rights and struggles of equity seeking groups, with focus on racialized groups, differently-abled people, aboriginal people and members of the GBLT(gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender people) community. Participants look at ways to fight divisions and discrimination – build solidarity and diversity in our Union.

HEALTH & SAFETY REPRESENTATIVES

This course is for Health and Safety Representatives in Canada Post workplaces with fewer than 20 workers – where no joint Health & Safety Committee is required. It is built around CUPW's Health & Safety Tool Kit, a binder of useful information is sent to the reps after their election.

BENEFITS

This course will provide participants with indepth knowledge on the benefits that have been negotiated so that they can answer questions that member may have. Priority will be given to executive members who deal with benefits on behalf of the Local.

Interested members should be aware that all sessions of the course are mandatory and to refrain from wearing any fragrance or scented products during the sessions to protect those with fragrance sensitivity allergies. Participants are expected to share accommodations.
