Calgary Local # 710 Consultation update:

Once again we consulted with the Employer about their idea of changing the sections on the Letter side of the Plant from

Inward and Outward to

S/L Originating (VES and S/L), EFM & MLOCR and S/L Incoming (FSM, O/S & Regional Finals).

The Employer is not ready to change their mind about having 3 sections instead of 2. Seems like they want to wait and see if it will work or not, see what the other major cities in the Region are doing and see if the other major cities are "structurally" the same!!

Although we stressed:

- VES with diminishing Short & Long sortation will cause numerous injuries.
- There is, in fact, not a rotation of duties in VES with diminishing Short & Long
- Standing at the machines all day will cause injuries.

Nothing changed their minds.

Yet this is the same Corporation who stresses Health and Safety is so important!!!

THE EMPLOYER WILL PUT OUT A NOTICE ON MONDAY REGARDING THE BIDDING FOR THESE NEW SECTIONS.

The Employer will send a Rotation of Duties package for the 3 new sections on Monday, January 9, 2012 for Consultation.

Rotation of Duties Consultation will occur on
Thursday, January 12, 2012 at 7am.

Final Sort consultation:

We consulted with the Employer to-day about Depots 7&14 moving to Sunridge (Calgary East) and how that affects the Final Sort clerks who currently work in Depots 7 & 14.

The employer will be moving:

1 Registration position and 1 Part-Time P04 position from Depot 7

And 1 Registration position and 1 Part-Time P04 position from Depot 14 to Sunridge.

All Full- Time P04's in the Final Sort Section (Depots and Retail) will be able to bid on the 2 Registration positions moving to Sunridge.

All Part- Time P04's in the Final Sort Section (Depots and Retail) will be able to bid on the 2 Part-Time P04 positions moving to Sunridge.

The Employer should have the bid out next week to be implemented in March 2012
