

Notice of Motion

Changes to Article 7 Section 1 of the Calgary Local By-Laws

(all changes have been bolded)

Section 1 – Finances-General

Paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 & 15 Status Quo

16. Members attending any course or seminar organized by the Local shall be allowed per diem as per the National Constitution .
- a) Any member who both lives and works outside the corporate limits of the City of Calgary and who drives into Calgary in order to attend said course or seminar shall be paid a travel expense equal to the distance traveled multiplied by **31 cents per kilometer, or as stipulated in the National Constitution.**
 - b) **Any member attending any course or seminar, outside the corporate limits of the City of Calgary, which is organized or endorsed by the Calgary Local, shall be paid a travel expense equal to the distance traveled multiplied by 31 cents per kilometer, or as stipulated in the National Constitution.**
 - c) In the event of car / vehicle pooling the afore-mentioned travel expense shall only be paid to one (1) member. That member being the owner/operator of the vehicle used to attend the course or seminar.

Paragraphs 17, 18, & 19 Status Quo

20. A Shop Steward who both lives and works outside the corporate limits of the City of Calgary and who drives into Calgary in order to attend a scheduled Shop Stewards meeting shall be paid a travel expense equal to the distance traveled multiplied by **31 cents per kilometer, or as stipulated in the National Constitution**

In the event of car / vehicle pooling the afore-mentioned travel expense shall only be paid to one (1) Shop Steward. That Shop Steward being the owner/operator of the vehicle used to attend the meeting.


21. **A Shop Steward, who upon request of the Calgary Local, is required to conduct Calgary Local Union business in another work location outside the corporate limits of the City of Calgary and separate from their work location shall be paid a travel expense equal to the distance traveled multiplied by 31 cents per kilometer, or as stipulated in the National Constitution**

A Shop Steward, who upon request of the Calgary Local Union office is required to conduct Calgary Local Union business in another work location, **within the corporate limits of the City of Calgary and** separate from their work location shall be paid a travel expense equal to the distance traveled multiplied by 50 cents per kilometer.

Payment of said expense is subject to confirmation of request and documentation of said travel.

In the event of car / vehicle pooling the afore-mentioned travel expense shall only be paid to one (1) Shop Steward. That Shop Steward being the owner/operator of the vehicle used to attend the meeting.
